## Cambrians Sue Didion For Air Permit Violations

Cambria, Wisconsin — Cambrians for Thoughtful Development, U.A. (CTD), through their attorneys at the law firm of McGillivray, Westerberg and Bender, filed an amended complaint in their ongoing Clean Air Act lawsuit against Didion Milling, Inc. and sister company Didion Ethanol, LLC (Didion).

The amended complaint, filed late last week in U.S. District Court for the Western District of Wisconsin, is the second such lawsuit brought by CTD under citizen lawsuit provisions of the Clean Air Act.

Among the eight Causes of Action listed in the complaint:

- Operation in Violation of Permit.
- Violation of Wis. Admin. Code § NR 415.03, which prohibits “caus[ing] allow[ing] or permit[ing] particulate matter to be emitted into the ambient air which substantially contributes to exceeding of an air standard, or creates air pollution.”
- Construction of Hammermills Without a Permit.
- Concealing Emissions By Tampering With or Rendering A Monitoring Device Inaccurate.

CTD seek, among other remedies, a permanent end to Didion's violations, independent third-party emissions monitoring and maximum fines of \$37,500.00 per day for each violation. Didion has been in violation of permits for a number years and daily violations are ongoing.
