**Cambria Village Planning Commission Recommends "NO" To Didion Permit**

Cambria, WI, May 16th, 2003

Citing numerous reasons, the Cambria Village Planning Commission voted unanimously Thursday night to recommend the Village Board of Cambria deny a zoning permit for Didion Milling's proposed ethanol plant.

---

**• Among the reasons cited for denying a zoning permit:**

1) Didion has not supplied the village with the requested hydrogeological test data regarding a proposed high capacity well.

2) The Wisconsin DNR has denied Didion Milling's request to permit two high capacity wells with a total capacity of 1000 gallons per minute.

3) The clear majority of voters in Cambria voted against Didion's proposed expansion.

**• It is expected the Village Board will act upon this recommendation at their next monthly board meeting. Cambrians For Thoughtful Development (CTD) urge the Village Board to follow the Planning Commission's recommendation and deny the permit.**
